

## The Lazarus Project

Following the creation of our linked Diocese of False Bay in 2005, the Diocese decided that they would have a Lent Appeal each year for a particular project. The first of these projects was the Lazarus Project at St Mark's Church Lavender Hill. The project was to build a hall facility for us by the Church and community to provide pre-school education, after school education and space for primary and secondary children in one of the most deprived informal settlements on the edge of Khayelitsha.

The project has been a great success and the Diocese has raised over 2 million Rand (£200,000) to enable the building to be erected and it is already in use in the community. The project needs an injection of funds to complete the work and furnish the building so that the work can advance.
